Heavy rainfall likely in these states; IMD issues red alert for Maharashtra

IMD has issued a red alert for heavy rainfall in southwest Madhya Pradesh] and similar activity is expected in other regions- The India Meteorological Department ¼IMD½ on Friday issued a red alert for southwest Madhya Pradesh] predicting extremely heavy rainfall for the next three days- The weather forecasting agency suggested similar rainfall activity in southeast Madhya Pradesh and Vidarbha on September 15] in north Madhya Maharashtra on September 15] and in the Gujarat region from September 16&17- PWest Madhya Pradesh is on red alert as it expects isolated heavy to very heavy rainfall] including extremely heavy

downpours ¼exceeding 204-4 mm½] from September 15th to 17th- Stay prepared and stay safe! IMD said in a social media post- The IMD has also issued orange alerts for Uttarakhand] Vidarbha] Saurashtra and Kutch] Marathwada] Madhya Pradesh] Konkan and Goa] which are likely to receive 115-6 to 204-4 mm rainfall- The well&marked low&pressure area that moved from the northwest Bay of Bengal and adjoining North Odisha&West Bengal coasts now lies over East Madhya Pradesh- It is likely to move across West Madhya Pradesh and Gujarat during the next 3&4 days- PA trough runs from southwest Rajasthan to north
